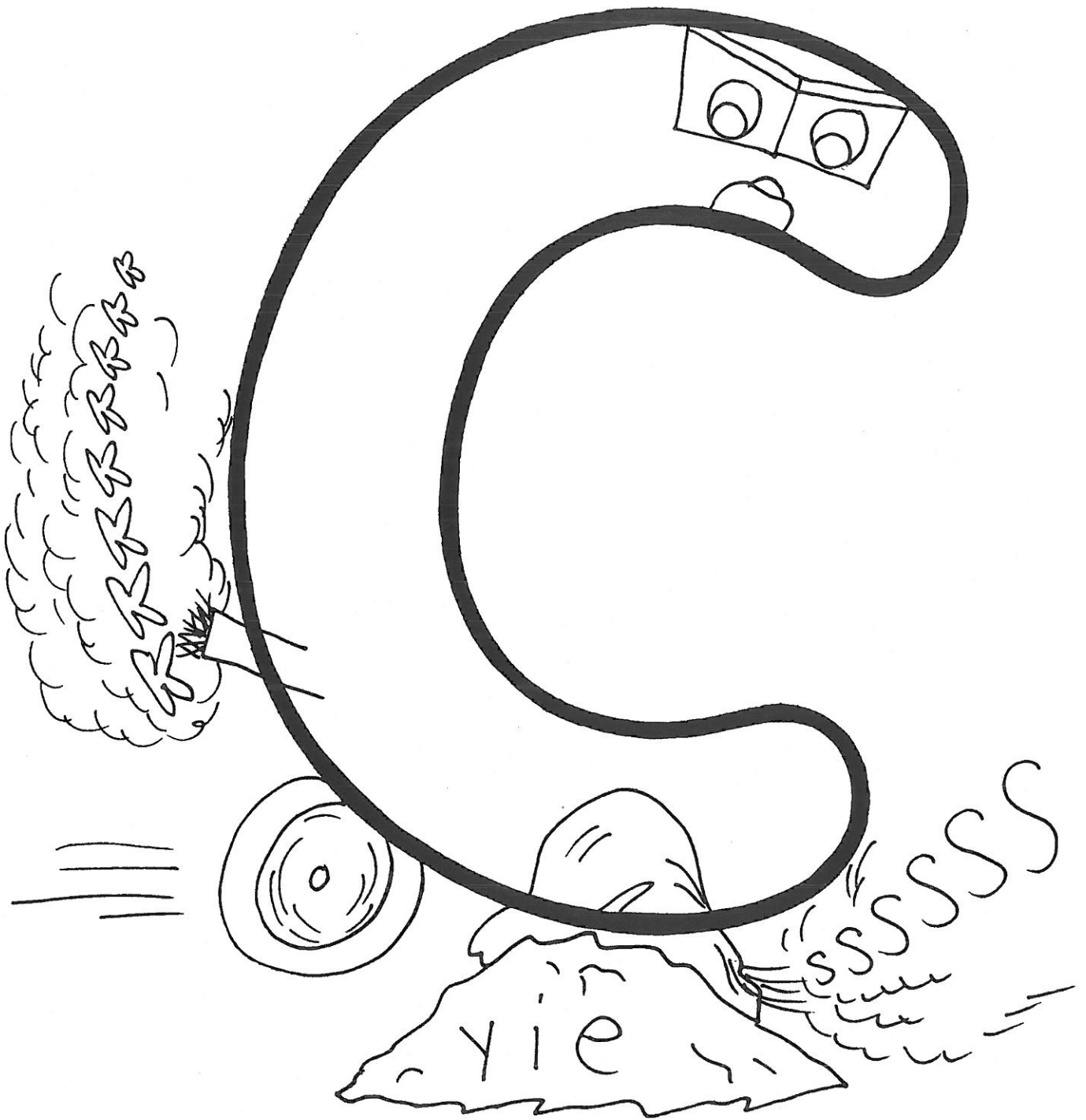

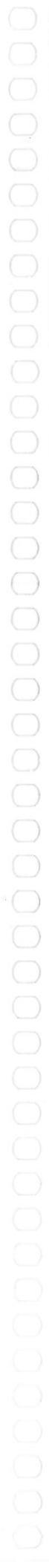
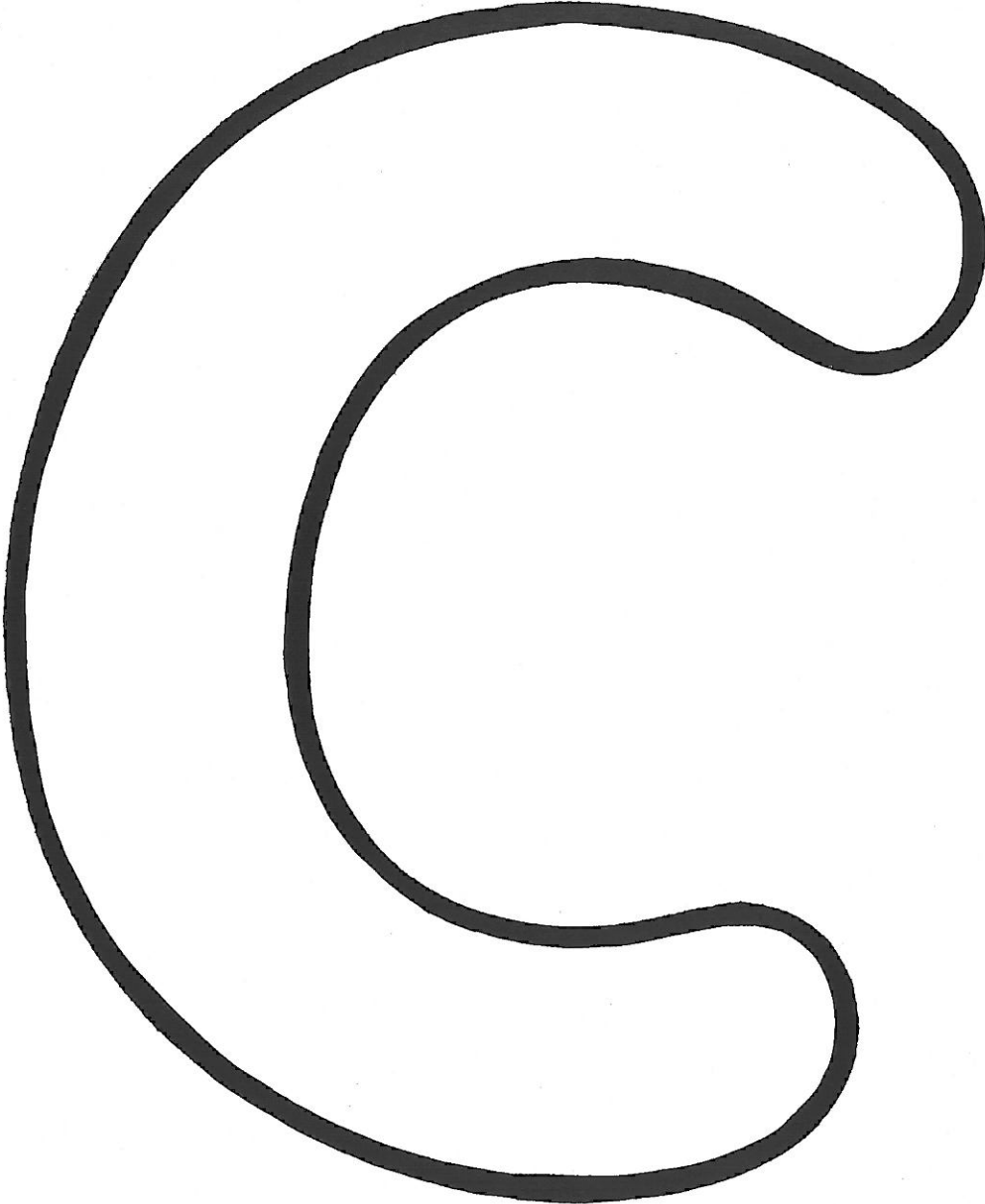


Car Sound

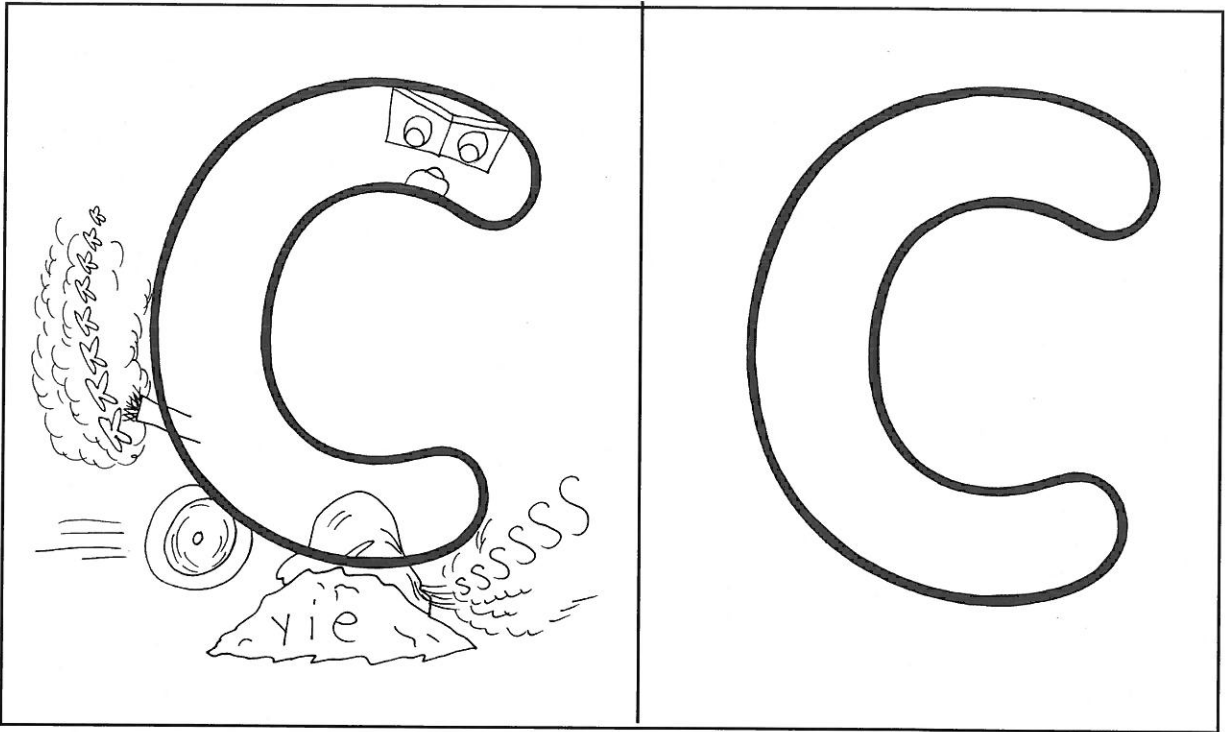
Story – Usually the car says, “K-k-k,” but when it comes before the sharp rock that has the letters Y, I, or E on it, it gets a flat tire, and small, quiet air comes out – “S-s-s-s.”

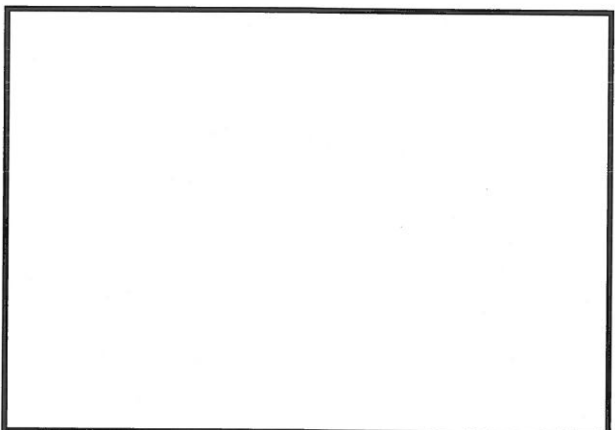
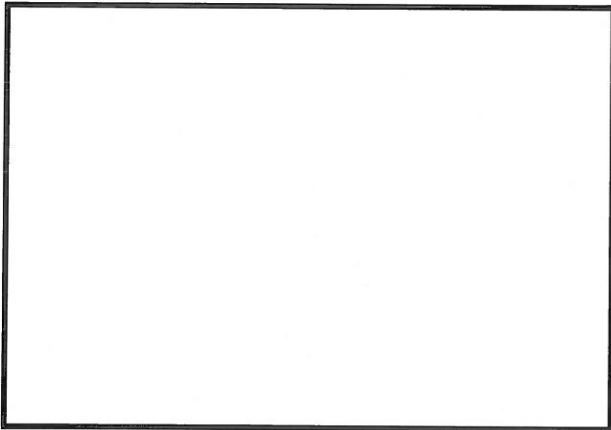
Hand cue: Hold your hand out, forming the shape of a C by cupping your hand. Move it along saying, “K-k-k.” When it hits the sharp rock (Y, I, or E), pretend to pull small air out of your mouth, “S-s-s.”

Draw 2 things that begin with this sound.

C – The Car Sound

(as another quiet choking sound)

(Show picture.) “Usually, the letter **C** sounds just like a car, ‘K-k-k-k.’ It’s really the same sound as the quiet, choking sound, ‘k.’ Do you remember that sound? This is a quiet little car, going along saying, ‘K-k-k-k.’ (Put your thumb and index finger into the shape of a **c** and move it along like a car chugging along.) See all those **K**’s coming out of the back? That just reminds us that this letter sounds like a **K** most of the time, ‘K-k-k-k.’”

*Hand cue: Put your thumb and index finger into the shape of a **C** and move it along like a car chugging along.*
