


Where to find your student's Summative ELPAC Scores

1. Log into your parent portal: [Pathways Parent Portal](#)
2. Click on "Reports" and then "Test Result"



3. This will bring you to all of your student's test results. You will find the summative ELPAC here
 - a. Select the score file listed as "ESA SCORE REPORT 2022 PDF"
 - b. ESA=ELPAC Summative Assessment. EIA= ELPAC Initial Assessment
 - c. Select the ESA=ELPAC Summative Assessment Score Report as indicated in the picture below



4. Select the score file listed as "ESA SCORE REPORT 2022 PDF"
 - a. ESA=ELPAC Summative Assessment. EIA= ELPAC Initial Assessment
5. Your student's report will look like this- (This is a fake score report) You may download, save, or print your students' report.

What is the ELPAC?

The ELPAC measures the English language proficiency skills that students need to succeed in school. Students who are English learners take the Summative ELPAC each spring until reclassified. Your child’s ELPAC results are only one measure of your child’s knowledge and skills in English. Other measures may include classroom tests, homework, and grades.


