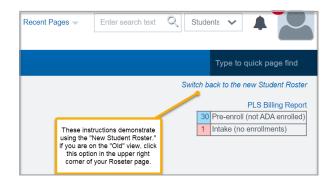

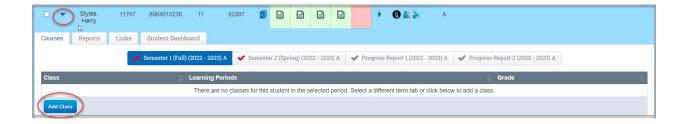

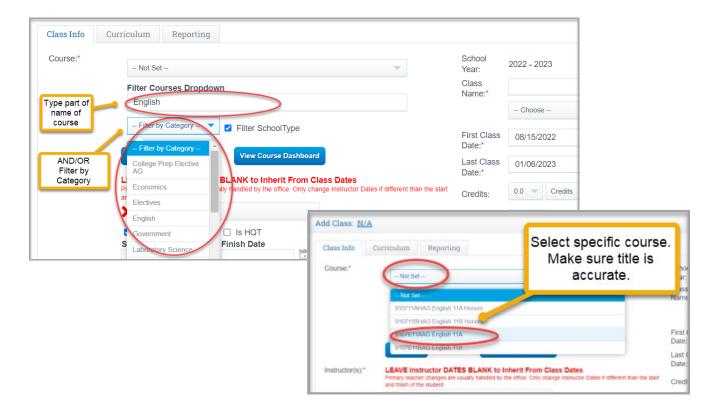
IN PATHWAYS, GO TO STUDENT COURSES FOR DESIRED SCHOOL YEAR





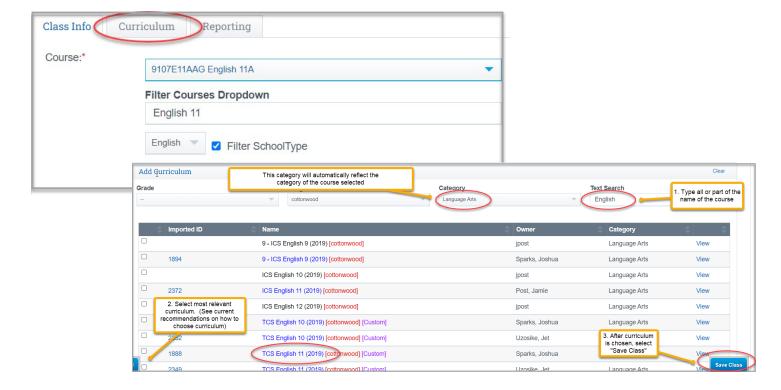
CREATE COURSES

Students must be enrolled in at least 20 credits per semester prior to creating ISA. If courses are added or deleted, an addendum must be completed prior to the semester add/drop deadline.



ADD CURRICULUM TO COURSE

This step can be done any time before AWRs are added for student's first LP. It does not have to be completed before creating Indepenent Study Agreement. (because ISA does not list curriculum). Be sure to use latest guidance in choosing most appropriate curriculum.



ADD SECOND SEMESTER COURSES

Repeat the process for second semester. Make sure that you are in the Semester 2 tab with each course you add. Pathways will default to Semester 1. If courses change for Semester 2, an addendum can be completed at the beginning of Semester 2.
