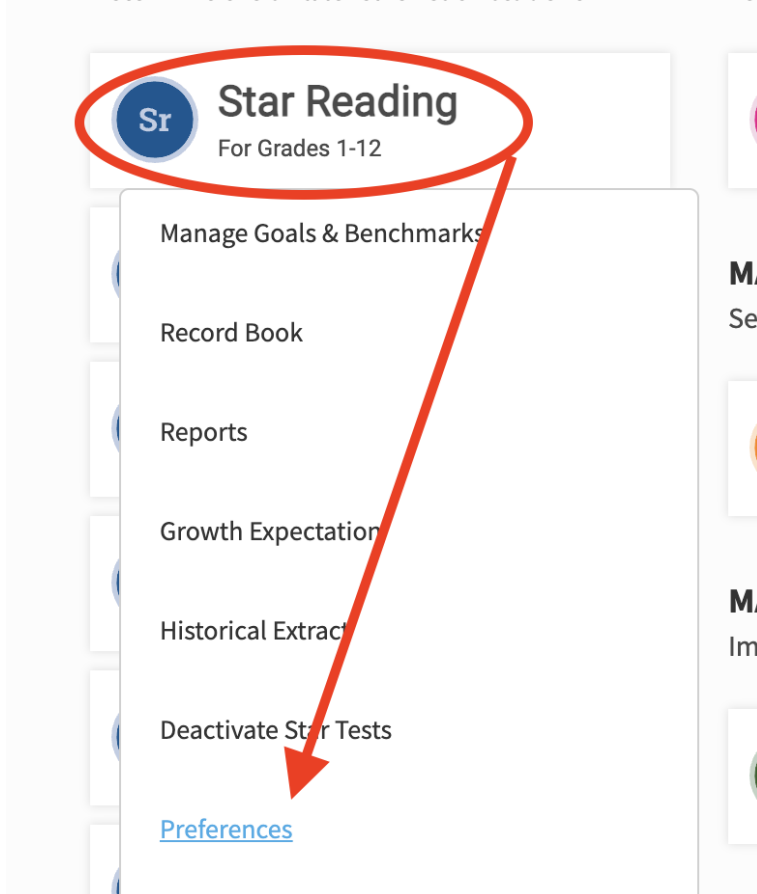


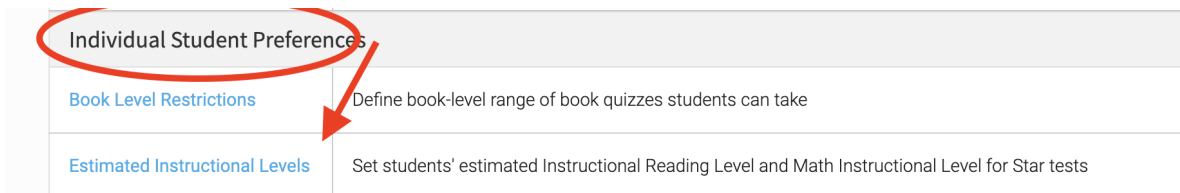
Lowering the Estimated Grade Level in Renaissance

Please follow these steps to lower the instructional level only if your student is below grades level. This will start the assessment at a lower level. It will not keep it from getting harder as it is an adaptable test.

1. Login to your Clever account
2. Click Renaissance Button
3. Select Reading or Math & scroll down to Preferences



4. Scroll down to Individual Student Preferences & Select Estimated Instruction Levels



5. Select the student you wish to change the settings for and toggle which grade level you would like the test to be set to for reading and math.
