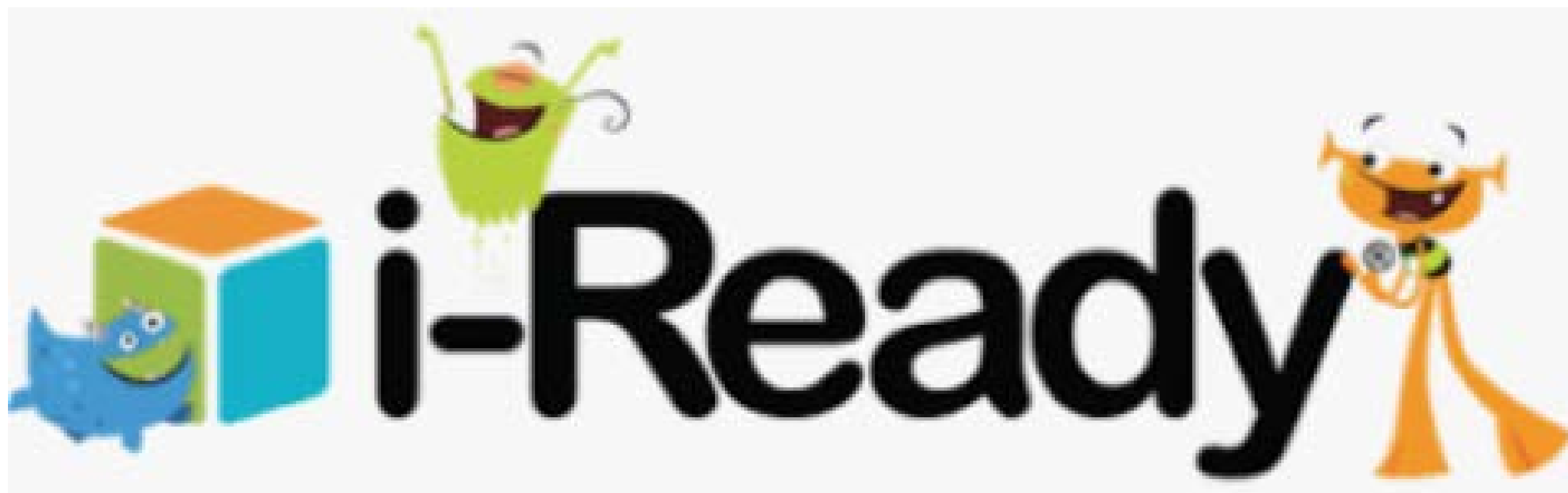

DIAGNOSTIC



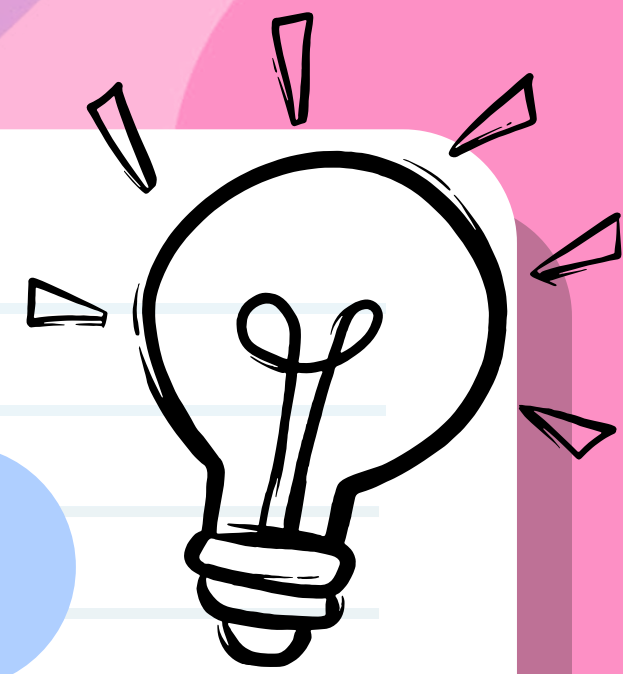
Students just go to Clever, click iReady, and choose Math or ELA to begin the Diagnostic. That's it!

After about 20 minutes, iReady will prompt them to take a Brain Break. That's a great stopping point if they'd like to break the test up over several days. They can take their own breaks at any time.

They have up to 10 days to complete each Diagnostic once they begin.

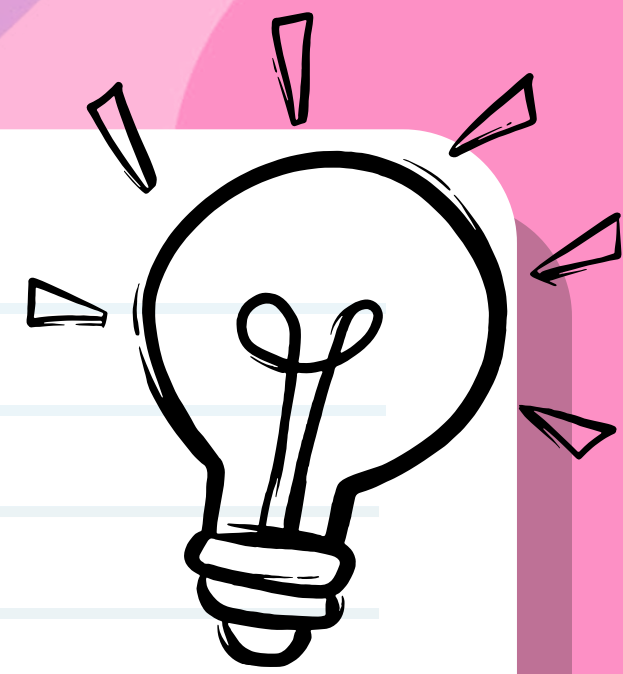
